#### Department for Education Launch of RSE/PSHE Call for Evidence

The DfE has launched a call for evidence to gather views of interested organisations on how relationships education, including relationships and sex education (RSE) for older children, should be taught in schools. In the Diocese of Lancaster, this is done through the Human Relationships and Sex Education programme (HRSE).

The call for evidence is open until 12 February 2018. This call for evidence is separate to the public consultation which is to be launched at a later date.

Please be assured that the Diocese has been engaged with the CES on an RSE curriculum for a considerable time.

The call for evidence and process of broader engagement aims to gather views on the content and teaching of these subjects. It will look to establish:

- -what teachers think they should be teaching their pupils to help them navigate the modern world they are growing up in;
- -how parents expect their children to be educated about this topic in a safe and age-appropriate way; and
- -what young people themselves think they would benefit from learning in these subjects.
