#### **Attendance**

Last week our whole school attendance dropped to 91% - the lowest figure all year. School attendance and individual pupil attendance should be 95% or above. Attendance for the whole year is currently 94.79%. Please ensure your child attends regularly for the remainder of the term. If we do not get this figure back above 95% it will reflect badly in our next Ofsted inspection.
