Weekly Challenge

Lego League

Lego League Club will now be called Lego Robot Programming on a Tuesday after school (3.15 - 4.15pm) for Years 4 and 5. There will be a general Lego Club on Thursday lunchtimes for Years 3 to 6.

Stay and Read

On the first Friday of each month we will hold a stay and read session. Parents are invited into school to read with their child. They can either read their individual reading book or choose one from the class reading area. Reading records must then be completed. The session will last for 15 minutes, until 9.15am. The first session will take place on **Friday 7**th **February**.

Speed Read

The school will be holding a Speed Read event for pupils and their families on **Monday 23rd March, 5pm-6.30pm**. Teachers will read short stories or extracts in their classrooms and plan a short activity to follow. Each session will last no longer than 20-25minutes. Mr McGoldrick will carry out an introduction in the school hall at 5pm and there will be a list of classrooms and texts displayed for you to choose from. After your first session, the school bell will ring and you can move to another classroom of your choice. There should be enough time to visit three classrooms.

Homework

You may have noticed that the spellings format in Key Stage 2 (juniors) has changed slightly recently. Mr McGoldrick will be sending out a separate letter regarding homework next week.

First Holy Communion

We have had several children sign up for the First Holy Communion Programme. The programme will begin with an Enrolment Mass at all Churches on Sunday 2nd February where the candidates will be presented to the Parish Community. The programme sessions will take place at St Mary's Church and the Parish Centre and are for parents and children to attend together. The children will have their own preparation with parish catechists and Fr Manny will lead the sessions for the parents.

There will be three sessions to prepare for the Sacrament of Reconciliation and four to prepare for First Communion. The last session will be a practical one to discuss what happens on the day and will finish with Eucharistic Adoration in Church.

Each session will begin in St Mary's Church at 6.30pm where we will celebrate Mass. Then we will move over to the Parish centre for the preparation sessions. The sessions will finish at about 7.45pm.

During the week beginning 23rd March arrangements will be made in each church for the children to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. More details will be given nearer the time.

FIRST COMMUNION DAY will be Sunday 17th May.

The Rededication of England as the Dowry of Mary
