# **Dropping-off & Collection**

**DROPPING-OFF** 

- The entrance gate does not open until 8.45am. Please try not to arrive before this time.
- Only one adult per family is permitted. It is not one adult per child.
- We aim for all children to be in class ready to start their school day by 8.55am. Therefore, the entrance gate is closed at 9am. If you arrive after this time, please bring your child via the Main Entrance and sign them in.

#### COLLECTION

- Years 5 & 6 can now be collected at 3.20pm. This is due to how well and quickly the collection has gone so far.
- When collecting children from Nursery to Year 1 please remember to stick to the edge of the playground and go around the cones when exiting, unless you are collecting children from another year group. Do not cut across the playground.
- Please keep your children with you at all times. Do not let them run around.
- Children must not use the play equipment. This is only used by one bubble and is not sterilised after use. We want to ensure there is not any cross-infection.

#### **School Bus**

This is a gentle reminder that the deadline to book children onto the school bus for the following week is 12noon on a Thursday.

#### **Extended Schools**

Breakfast and After School Club will recommenced this week. You must book in by 12noon the day before via LunchShop.
