Support Staff Day



Christmas Performance

We will be holding separate performances for the infants (Rec to Y2) and juniors (Y3-Y6), but we have decided to reduce the hall capacity by half (audiences of 80 max). The infants and juniors will each hold three performances on one day to accommodate the reduced audience capacity – we do not want any disappointed parents. Tickets will initially be limited to 2 per child. Ticket

holders will also be asked to do an LFT on the day of the performance they are attending. In addition, they **must** wear a mask (unless exempt) and remain seated throughout the performance.

Tickets are now available from the school office. Tickets are £1 each (adult and children). Children will need their own ticket and seat. The cost of the tickets covers the performance licence and goes towards covering the cost of the panto. Tickets will be limited to 2 people for the infant performance and 2 people for the junior performance (per child). Please provide names of attendees for track and trace purposes. If your child comes to and from school on the school bus or goes to Breakfast/After School Club please place the correct money in an envelope with your child's name, year group, who will be attending, number of tickets you require (2 max.) and which performance you wish to attend (morning, afternoon or evening). Tickets will be issued on a first come, first served basis. The deadline to purchase tickets is 3rd December at noon. If we have tickets remaining, we will allow families to purchase additional tickets.

COVID Symptoms, Tests and Results

IMPORTANT: We ask that parents and carers report all COVID symptoms, tests and results to the school office via telephone. We understand they may wish to inform staff via ClassDojo too, but please ensure that the school office is informed so we can update our records and keep a track of current, suspected and confirmed cases. Please also inform us if a member of the household has tested positive.

Christmas Post Box (Pius Post)

Pius Post is now open for business! The post box is in the hall. Pupils should clearly write the names and classes on the front of each card, for example 'Joe Bloggs (Year 4)' and post them into the post box. Remember to include surnames in case there is more than one child with the same forename in the class. Our School Council will then sort and deliver the cards to each class. Children should not hand their own Christmas cards in class or in the playground.
