Attendance

Our attendance figure has dropped in recent weeks. We will be monitoring attendance closely in coming weeks. Please be warned that any pupils who have an attendance below 90% may be placed on an action plan, which will be monitoring by the Education Welfare Officer. In addition, please be aware we will be monitoring lateness. We have some children who arrive to school late on a regular basis and therefore miss some vital learning. School starts promptly at 8:55am, which is when the gates are locked.

Crossing

Reminder: We have recently had some near misses reported due to families crossing from the corner nearest Pius Hall towards Ormsgill Lane. This is extremely dangerous. We have had some fatal accidents outside of school in the past. Please cross via the school crossing. We appreciate the fact we do not have a crossing patrol is frustrating. We continue to advertise the role.

Water Bottles

Reminder: Children should only have fresh water in their water bottles. No juice please. In addition, we have been made aware that several children may have medication in their bottles (e.g. Movicol) — this is not permitted unless an Individual Health Care Plan has been completed with Mrs Hurley. Medical evidence must be provided. Medicated water bottles will be stored separately and out of reach of other children.

Reminder: At the end of this term, we have three members of staff leaving us. Mrs Reid is leaving to carry out grandparent duties. Mrs Imison and Miss Haslam are leaving to start pastures new. They will all be missed, and we wish them the best of luck in the future.
